#### **Holy Communion – Common Cup**

After much thought and prayer, we have now moved away from Intinction at Holy Communion. We are reverting to our usual (pre-covid) practice of joining the Communion Rail from the left, if you sit in church on the left and from the right, if you sit in church on the right.

All communicants can receive the wafer and then they may drink from the Common Cup. Individual Intinction is not permissible.

You can choose to receive just the wafer, as on liturgical and theological levels, anyone who has received communion in one kind, has received full communion.
