Connect Services – Summer Holidays

As is usual practice, we will not be having our Connect Services during the August School Summer Holidays. There will be our 9.00 am Holy Communion Service to which all are most welcome.

Receiving Holy Communion – Common Cup

After much thought and prayer, we have now moved away from Intinction at Holy Communion. We are reverting to our usual (pre-covid) practice of joining the Communion Rail:

If you sit in church on the left, please stand on the left in the Chancel.

If you sit in church on the right, please stand on the right in the Chancel.

Please wait for the Serving Team to have received their Communion and to have left the Communion Rail before joining the Communion Rail yourself.

All communicants can receive the wafer and then they may drink from the Common Cup. Individual Intinction is not permissible.

You can choose to receive just the wafer, as on liturgical and theological levels, anyone who has received communion in one kind, has received full communion.
